

Emergency medical Care on the Holidays

(379) 「休日急患診療所」について

If you are struck with an acute illness or injury on a holiday, you can receive initial evaluation and care at a Holiday Emergency Clinic in Kawasaki City (*kyūjitsu kyūkan shinryō jo*, 休日急患診療所). Treatment is offered in internal medicine and pediatrics. The clinics are open on Sundays, holidays and from December 29th to January 3rd every year. They receive patients between 9 and 11:30 a.m. and between 1 and 4 o'clock p.m.

Here are the phone numbers of the Holiday Emergency Clinics for each ward:

Kawasaki Holiday Emergency Clinic, 2 1 1 – 6 5 5 5.

Saiwai Holiday Emergency Clinic, 5 5 5 – 0 8 8 5.

Nakahara Holiday Emergency Clinic, 7 2 2 – 7 8 7 0.

Takatsu Holiday Emergency Clinic, 8 1 1 – 9 3 0 0.

Miyamae Holiday Emergency Clinic, 8 5 3 – 2 1 3 3.

Tama Holiday Emergency Clinic, 9 3 3 – 1 1 2 0.

Asao Holiday Emergency Clinic, 9 6 6 – 2 1 3 3.

Hiroshige Utagawa Exhibit at Kawasaki City Museum

(380) 「市民ミュージアム企画展」について



This year is the 150th anniversary of the death of the world-famous artist Hiroshige Utagawa (歌川広重), and to mark the occasion all 120 images from his well-known work One Hundred Famous Views of Edo (*meisho edo hakkei*, 名所江戸八景), created late in his life, are on display now at Kawasaki City Museum.

In addition, this exhibition explores the way the ordinary people's view of what constituted a 'notable place' broadened over time, from locations within the Edo city limits outward to include places ever further afield. So, images of several other areas are included in this exhibition.

The show provides an introduction to the kind of travel guidebooks of which so many were published in Edo-period Japan. In addition, a number of *sugoroku* (双六) Japanese traditional board games are on display.

The exhibition continues until Monday, January 12, 2009 – which happens to be the national holiday *seijin no hi* (成人の日), Coming-of-Age Day, in Japan.

Admission is 600 yen for adults, 400 yen for high school students and for people 65 years of age and up,

and free for elementary and middle school students.

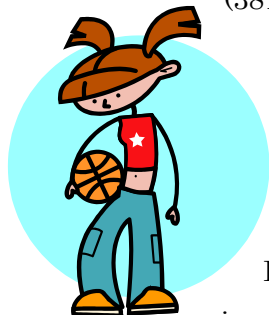
