Persons who wish to apply for public housing, but who are not sure how, can attend this session and get help filling out their forms.

(Public housing is:) constructed jointly by city and national governments (but owned by the city) for low-income people with housing problems to rent at reasonable rates. Unlike on the private market, there's an application period, income criteria, and other rules. There's no key money or renewal fee, but a tenant's income is checked every year to determine their rental rate.

[Application criteria:] (1) legally an adult in Japan

- (2) resident of Kawasaki City or have worked at the same job in Kawasaki for at least a year
- (3) monthly income not above a certain level
- (4) having serious problems related to housing
