
Promenade of Light and Sound

You are expected to send Nengajo or New Year's cards to the animals at Yumemigasaki Animal Park.


New Year's cards received by the Yumemigasaki Animal Park from December 15 to January 16th, 2005 will be put up on a special display within the park from January 28th to February 14th.

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Yonetty Ozenji



Yonetty Ozenji in Asao Ward is a combined facility of a relaxation room for older people and a heated swimming pool complex utilizing surplus heat by burning waste at a boiler.

There are one heated pool with a strong flow or current at the center and a 25 meter pool, a pool for children as well as a pool with slide attached. You can use the pool area from 10:00am to 8:30pm.

Tickets are available to buy until 7:30pm.

Tickets cost ¥300 for 1 hour and ¥150 for an extra 30 minutes for people aged over 15 years old. For people from aged 3 to aged under 15 years old and junior high school students a ticket costs ¥100 for an hour and ¥50 for an extra 30 minutes.

There is also a training room at Yonetty Ozenji with the opening times of 9:00am to 12:00pm, from 1:00pm 4:00pm and also from 5:00pm to 8:00pm. You have to pay separately for each period. The cost is ¥300 for those aged over 20 years old and ¥100 for people aged from age 15 to under age 20 and it is also ¥100 if you are a student, even if you are over 20 years old.


Also at Yonetty Ozenji there is a 35 tatami mat size relaxation room with baths for those aged over 60 for free. It is open from 9:00am to 4:00pm.

As well as the above facilities you can also play gate-ball, hold meetings and do other activities at Yonetty Ozenji .

To get to Yonetty Ozenji take a bus from Kakio Station on the Odakyu Line, or you can catch the "Mizo 17" from Musashi-Mizonokuchi Station on the JR Nambu Line. You need to get off at the bus stop marked Den-en chofu Gakuen Daigaku. Furthermore, if you go to Yonetty Ozenji by car you have to pay ¥100 per hour for parking.

Except for the months of July and August Yonetty Ozenji is closed on Wednesdays. If Wednesday happens to be a national holiday Yonetty Ozenji will be open on the Wednesday but closed on the following day instead. Yonetty Ozenji will be closed for the New Year's Holiday between December 29th and January 5th.
