This is about a competition to help generate ideas for revitalizing empty shops in shopping areas of Kawasaki. Within the Kawasaki area specialists who help revitalizing

shopping areas are given some support by Kawasaki City government. As part of this support Kawasaki is organizing a Revitalization Idea Contest.

Kawasaki City is seeking young people who have original ideas and unique imaginative powers about how to help revitalize shopping areas and what to do about vacant shop lots to submit their ideas to this contest. If we can somehow encourage people to use shopping areas we will be able to brighten up these areas.
