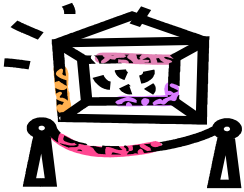


“Road to the complete <Tomorrow's myth>” Exhibition

Taro Okamoto spent his whole life pursuing connections between his art and society. And he created his mural “Tomorrow’s myth” as a guidepost for humanity in the modern age.

The Taro Okamoto Museum of Art has in its possession Okamoto’s original oil painting “Tomorrow’s myth”, which served as the basis for the mural. The museum’s current exhibition “Road to the complete <Tomorrow’s myth>” centers on this painting.

Along with it, photographs and video clips are used to explain the process of creating the mural, and to paint a picture of the day and age in which it was made. The exhibition will continue until Tuesday October the 3rd.

The 2006 Tamagawa Half Marathon in Kawasaki takes place on Sunday the 19th of November, but it’s already time to sign up if you’d like to participate. And wouldn’t it be nice to take a run in the fresh autumn breeze of the Tamagawa River?

There are four events to choose from: the half marathon, the 10-kilometer run, the 3-kilometer run, and the parent-child 1-kilometer pair run. Certificates of participation and medals will be given out, as will certificates of runners’ official times. Everybody who runs will get a T-shirt.

The Livestock Industry Food Fair 2006, called the "CHIKUSAN FOOD FAIR" in Japanese, will be held over two days on Saturday October 7th and Sunday October 8th in Higashi-Ogijima, Kawasaki Ward at the Japan Meat Trading Center (which is called the "NIHON SHOKUNIKU RYUTSU CENTER" in Japanese).

Various kinds of beef, pork, processed foods, etc. including top-grade beef from all parts of Japan will be on display and for sale. There will also be an outdoor barbecue corner, a petting zoo with calves, sheep, rabbits and so on, and there will even be ponies to ride.

On top of all that, right next door at Kawasaki Marien, the Kawasaki Port Festival will be going on. So bring your whole family for a really nice fall outing.

You get to the Japan Meat Trading Center by taking the "Kawa 05" bus from the bus terminal at the East exit of JR Kawasaki Station. Get off at the "Nihon Shokuniku Ryutsu Senta" bus stop.
